OWLED 2007 - Overview

- Bigger than ever!
 - More papers/attendees
 - OWLED'07: 46 papers, ~ 100 attendees
 - OWLED'06: 30 papers, ~ 60 attendees
 - and only ~6 months since last OWLED!
- Wide representation
 - Institutions: 20 companies/Research Labs, 36 Universities
 - Fields: Aeronautics Automotive Defense Biology Medicine etc.
 - Attendees: ~ 70 full, ~ 30 students
- Packed but exciting schedule
 - 12 Sessions + 3 Panels + 1 Poster/demo
